In North America, young lodge pole pines have been and still are used in most log railing construction. They are straight and strong, with small diameter and branches, aren't too hard, and have a lot of character; perfect material to use in building outdoor and indoor railings that lasts a lifetime.

We generally use a 4-5 inch top and bottom rail with 3-4 inch spindles. The spacing between the spindles is 4 inches or less as well as the distance from the bottom rail to the floor surface. This ensures that the rails will pass any codes. Our posts are made up from square cants. A post diameter will be used that best suits your needs.

The rails are hand drawn before they are cut to length. After they are drawn, they are cut to length and the ends are tenoned. They are then sanded smooth and ready to be installed. The rails are coated with respect to weather they are an interior rail or an exterior.
