

Custom Log Trusses

Trusses are used when a span is too great to use a traditional post and beam structure. In a great room, a truss will eliminate the need to have the post and beam structure in the way of the floor plan. A truss is also of great use on the exterior. It will remove the need for posts and open up your viewing area. Not only are trusses structurally important, they are also very pleasing to look at and will accent any room or overhang.

A basic truss that we use is the king truss. The king truss consists of two top chords, a bottom chord, two web members (that we generally set at a 45° angle) and a king post. 3/8 to 1/4 inch metal plating holds all the members together. The plating is designed to have 1 inch of relief on each side to allow for wane.

We make our trusses on site and ship them separately to the job location. This ensures total control over quality. Trusses however can be assembled on-site and is usually the preferred way for a qualified subcontractor.
